# COMMITTED VOLUNTEERS GO THE EXTRA MILE TO SUPPORT THE NEEDY IN NORTH WEST DISTRICT

1,200 volunteers from North West CDC's corporate and community network step up to provide better support and care to residents living in rental flats

The hallmark of **WeCare @ North West – Service Weeks**, North West Community Development Council (CDC)'s annual flagship programme, is the selfless contributions by the CDC's returning partners who volunteer their time and effort year after year. City Development Limited (CDL), a long-standing partner supporting the vulnerable residents in Limbang Division since 2016, exemplifies the strong community spirit and culture of giving back. Determined to do more in 2022 to serve the needy in the community, CDL will be providing home improvement items to meet pressing daily needs, including rice cookers, standing fans and other furniture items to nine households. In December 2021, CDL also championed two meaningful initiatives, a Grant-A-Wish programme to fulfil festive wishes of Children living in Limbang, as well as a Gift-A-Voucher initiative to encourage donations of \$20 supermarket vouchers for all residents of rental units in Limbang.

2 **Mr Chia Ngiang Hong, CDL Group General Manager**, says, "Through the City Sunshine Club campaigns, we hope to inspire and motivate our employees to engage in active volunteerism and join us in contributing to meaningful causes. We are humbled by the fulfilling opportunity during Service Weeks to interact with the Limbang community and bring cheer to the many low-income families during this festive season. CDL's long-standing partnership with NWCDC for distribution events kickstarted in 2016 and since then, CDL employees have reached out to the needy families with the contribution and distribution of essential items every year."

Joining the distribution efforts at Limbang Division on Saturday, 22 January 2022 as Guest-of-Honour, **Mr Lawrence Wong, Minister for Finance and Adviser to Marsiling-Yew Tee GRC Grassroots Organisations** says, "WeCare @ North West – Service Weeks has become a regular feature in our Limbang community outreach. I'm heartened to see the CDC and CDL come together in contributing resources to provide more support to the vulnerable residents. Their regular contribution over the years have forged a strong bond with our residents, who look forward to their presence every year." He will be accompanied by corporate volunteers from CDL and youth volunteers from North West Youth Assembly in distributing 315 festive packs to Limbang residents, which includes an additional packet of 5kg rice contributed by the Limbang Grassroots Organisations *(See Annex A for detailed media programme)*.

4 The Service Weeks 2022 campaign is currently at the midway mark. On 22 January 2022, the second weekend of Service Weeks, several corporate and community partners will also be contributing home improvement items at various sites. Aside from CDL, another corporate partner which is going the extra mile is Malayan Daching Co Pte Ltd. The company will be providing home improvement items ranging from furniture to electric appliances such as washing machine and refrigerator for 15 households at Marsiling Division. They have supported nearly 96 households for home improvement services since 2016. Master Contract Services Pte Ltd, which will be participating for the eighth time, will also be providing more care and support to residents of Chong Pang Division. They have helped 63 households with \$20,000 worth of painting services, household appliances and furniture since 2015. The company is also a donor of CDC's **Club-100 @ North West** programme.

5 This year, CDL, Malayan Daching Co Pte Ltd and Master Contract Services Pte Ltd are among over 1,200 volunteers from 60 corporate and community agencies who have partnered the North West CDC to spread festive cheer to over 20,000 residents living in the public rental units in the North West District. Tapping on the CDC as a strategic partner, which has established extensive networks with residents in the District, many partners have been able to contribute beyond the traditional distribution in Service Weeks. More partners are coming up with new initiatives to provide more support for the vulnerable community. Some companies participating in Service Weeks 2022 will provide home improvement items and services, while others supported with additional products such as vitamins, vouchers, and hygiene products. The campaign was officially launched on 15 January 2022 at Ulu Pandan Division.
