WIDER SELECTION OF NECESSITIES FOR NEEDY RESIDENTS

Over 280 residents living in Woodlands rental flats to choose 12 items contributed by partners

For the first time under the **WeCare** @ **North West – Service Weeks** programme, residents will be able to personally shop for their preferred items at a community minimart, instead of receiving a Festive Pack delivered by volunteers. The tweak in delivery method for the Festive Packs is the outcome of a collaboration between the North West Community Development Council (CDC) and Woodlands Grassroots Organisation (GRO), to provide more convenience and choice to residents. Due to the greater flexibility in the distribution, Woodlands residents can select from a wider selection ranging from cereals and snacks to breakfast spreads to frozen food products at the store. In addition to selecting 12 food necessities, residents will also receive three types of vitamin products sponsored by CDC's corporate partner, Guardian.

Joining the distribution efforts at Woodlands Division on Saturday, 29 January 2022 as Guest-of-Honour, **Ms Mariam Jaafar, Adviser to Sembawang GRC Grassroots Organisations** says, "It's wonderful to see the community come together to provide support for the residents under our care

ahead of the Lunar New Year. Working with the north West CDC to integrate the Service Weeks model with our community store, Store@Woodlands, will give our residents even more choices to select the food items they need to whip up healthier meals at home during this festive season."

- North West CDC's volunteers have once again come out in full force to support the modified method of distributing the CDC's Festive Packs. 10 volunteers from Select Group Pte Ltd and 5 volunteers from the North West Youth Assembly will be helping to stock up the minimart with the 11 items prepared by the CDC and its corporate sponsor. In addition, the volunteers will also guide residents on the selection and assist to bring up the items to residents who require more support.
- Over the final weekend of Service Weeks, the CDC expects to reach over 1,800 households across five Divisions Admiralty, Nee Soon East, Sembawang West, Woodgrove and Woodlands. Wrapping up the North West CDC's annual flagship programme, **Mayor of the North West, Mr Alex Yam** says "Service Weeks is CDC's staple programme, which we have run since 2014. While we have made constant enhancements over the years, we are still exploring new and innovative ways to serve the residents better. Following this edition, the CDC is looking to conduct more runs of Service Weeks and provide support in other necessities beyond food items."
- The three-week long Service Weeks campaign has provided much relief to nearly 22,000 residents across 14 North West Divisions with enhanced festive packs as well as additional support from partners. Despite the pandemic, some 1,200 corporate and community partners have rallied together to contribute their time and resources to provide more avenues of support, including allowing residents to customise their festive packs, and topping up additional home improvement items and vouchers to help residents in need.

Requirements due to Covid-19

- 1. All media are required to complete a self-administered ART test before arriving at the distribution site, and work with CDC staff to take your temperature on-site and complete a self-declaration form.
- 2. All media are required to use TraceTogether (either app or token) through the course of distribution.
- 3. All media should keep a safe distance of 1 metre from the resident, wear a face mask and frequently sanitise hands.
- 4. All media are to be accompanied by staff from the CDC Corporate Communications team for all media activities.
