Bee Koon is very involved in promoting healthier lifestyles and through her connections, has helped us, the CDC, to establish networks with Active SG sports coaches and speakers, as well as personally providing valuable feedback and strategic direction in shaping many of our Healthy Living programmes. Her contributions in bringing experts on board to share knowledge and practical insights have increased the quality of our workshops and activities to strengthen the impact of our healthy living programmes. Thank you, Bee Koon, well done.
- We also recognize our long-standing members who have contributed to our North West District for many decades, one of whom is, Mr Allen Ang. Allen is a long-standing District Councillor of 22 years. Thank you, Allen. He has contributed in many ways to the North West in different areas outside of his duties in the Green Living Standing Committee. Allen served as the Chairman of the North West Youth Concert organising committee for 10 years and has helped us to raise the profile of young people in our district, and also to raise funds for our needy residents, especially our students. Even though Allen will be stepping down this term as co-chair of Green Living Standing Committee, he will

continue to serve as our District Councillor and provide his muchneeded guidance and experiences with our newer DCs. Thank you, Allen for that as well.

 Many who have served in our 8th Term Council have made significant contributions of which, I am unable to thank each one of you. But please be assured that you have my greatest appreciation for your dedication to our cause and to serve our residents, despite the difficulties of Covid.

Future Plan for 9th Term Council

- Today we also officially appoint the 9th Term of Council, comprising 63 District Councillors, with 24 of you being new to our Council. The new line-up includes several experienced District Councillors who have served the North West for many years, and also passionate individuals from public and private sectors, with varying industries such as healthcare, education, social support, and SME business owners, comprising different viewpoints, different experiences and expertise to help us increase the colour and chemistry that we have in our North West district, to better serve our residents.
- Amongst the newly appointed DCs, we have also have more representatives from the social service agencies to enable us to have more touch points with the community and provide more comprehensive support to meet the different needs of our residents.
- We are excited to have these passionate individuals join our Council, bringing a unique blend of skills and expertise, which will of course value-add to spearheading our ideas and providing direction for our programmes.
- Two new programmes that we rolled out this year are: HealthierSG Fest which has just concluded in June and was held over two days, to

encourage residents to lead a healthier lifestyle. This is something that we will continue to run to encourage and help residents take responsibility of their health.

- In addition, the upcoming North West Sustainability Festival in November will encourage our residents to take up green practices at home, and help them kick-start their green journey.
- Our next big event, you will see the flyers on the table, this is our Club-100 Charity Golf which is coming up on 17th October. One, you get to network with fellow district councillors and make new friends and all for good cause as we support our platform in raising funds for our community. The event provides a platform for us to fundraise and to give more assistance to North West residents. We seek our council members' support to share this with your network. - The CDC will continue to explore other areas of needs, to encourage residents to lead a healthier lifestyle, and develop new exciting ideas with our new term of Council.
